USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY
EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

- ~ Out of bounds is designated by white stakes or inside edge of perimeter roadways.
- ~ All penalty areas are designated by red stakes or red lines and yellow stakes or yellow lines.
- ~ Irrigation control boxes are immovable obstructions - free relief from stance and swing.
- ~ Wooden/Stone retaining walls are played as immovable obstructions - free relief from stance and swing.
- ~ Coquina areas are an integral part of the course. Play the ball as it lies.
- ~ Reclaimed water is used for irrigation.
- ~ If a ball lies in the general area and an immovable obstruction within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take free relief as follows:
The nearest point of complete relief should be identified and a ball must be dropped in and come to rest in the relief area. The relief area must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.

CLUB RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- ~ Carts must remain on cart paths around tees and greens.
- ~ Carts must remain on cart paths on all par 3's.
- ~ Starters and On Course Professionals are provided for the benefit of all golfers. Golfers must follow their instructions.
- ~ Place rake outside bunker after use.
- ~ Repair ball marks and fill divots with sand provided.
- ~ Thorguard Lightning System: One long blast indicates play must stop and players must seek shelter. Shelter Locations: 12 green/2 tee and 6 green/7 tee. Three short blasts indicate play may resume and players can return to their position on the course.
