USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY  
EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

- ~ Out of bounds is designated by white stakes or inside edge of perimeter roadways.
- ~ All lateral water hazards are designated by red stakes or red lines.
- ~ Inside edge of pedestrian paths on holes 1 & 2 are out of bounds.
- ~ Hole 4 to the right of the cart path is a lateral water hazard.
- ~ Irrigation control boxes are immovable obstructions - free relief from stance and swing.
- ~ Wooden/Stone retaining walls are played as immovable obstructions - free relief from stance and swing.
- ~ Reclaimed water is used for irrigation.
- ~ If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take free relief as follows:  
The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

CLUB RULES AND ETIQUETTE

- ~ Carts must remain on cart paths around tees and greens.
- ~ Carts must remain on cart paths on all par 3's.
- ~ Starters and On Course Professionals are provided for the benefit of all golfers. Golfers must follow their instructions.
- ~ Place rake outside bunker after use.
- ~ Repair ball marks and fill divots with sand provided.
- ~ Thorguard Lightning System: One long blast from the sirens indicates play must stop and players must seek shelter. Shelter Locations: 5 green/11 tee, 9 green and 11 green/15 green. Three short blasts from the sirens indicate play may resume and players can return to their position on the course.
